PLANT LIST

FLOWERS & PATIO PLANTS

Easy Wave Petunia 10" hanging basket - mounded, spreading petunias loaded with blooms all season long. Prefers full sun; tolerates heat well. Fertilize weekly for best results. Plant spread: 30-39"; plant height: 6-12"

Suntastic Sunflower – dwarf, well-branched sunflower boasting a profusion of large blossoms up to 6". Blooming in summer over three successive periods, it produces up to 20 flowers per plant. Perfect for pots, window boxes or low bedding. Prefers full sun and well-drained soil. Plant spread: 8-10"; plant height: up to 20"

Hibiscus Luna (perennial) – dramatic and impressive, Luna's huge 6-8" flowers are produced on big, bushy well-branched plants. Excellent in large containers. Grows 2-3' high with a spread of 2'. Mix of colors: **pink swirl** – flowers have a dark eye and pink picotee pattern, being darker on the edge of the petals and lighter towards the center; **red** - rich red flowers; **rose** – deep, clear rose; blooms slightly earlier and has largest flowers vs. the other colors; **white** – white flowers with large red eye

Marigolds – cheerful, hardy, and easy to grow; features 2" anemone type flowers supported by strong stems on well-branched plants. At a final garden height of 10-12", they make quite a show. Plant generously for control of pests around vegetables and ornamental plants – around the perimeter of your garden, between rows of vegetables, or in groupings

Delizz Strawberry – a delightful, super sweet tasting, bite-sized snack that is easy to grow. This ever-bearing type produces about 45 strawberries per plant and grows well in containers or in the garden. Full sun; blooms spring to autumn frost; maturity: 60 days. Plant spread and height: 6-12"

Patio Baby Eggplant – compact, dwarf eggplant that produces loads of 3" dark purple sweetly flavored fruits. Perfect for containers or small garden spaces. Fast maturing; full sun; plant spread: 20"; plant height: 24"

HERBS

Rutgers Devotion Basil – Forms large, cupped leaves with a slightly sweet and spicy aroma. Compact plant is highly productive. Great in pesto, Italian dishes or in fresh salads or soups. Height 18-20"

Catnip – a member of the herb family, containing oils known to entice cats. It is used fresh or dried in cat bedding and cat toys. Also useful as an herbal tea for insomnia, fevers and colds. Height up to 3'

Rosemary – an outstanding culinary herb! This upright, bushy, pine scented herb is the original rosemary variety. Noted for its green needle-like foliage it is perfectly flavored and can be used with any meat or poultry dish and for seasoning vegetables. Height 39"

Phenomenal Lavender (perennial) – a hybrid developed with winter hardiness and a good resistance to heat, humidity, foliage and root diseases. Grows uniformly into a round shape of dense silvery-green foliage topped with tall wands of rich lavender-purple flowers and wonderful fragrance. Full sun; plant spread: 18-24"; plant height: 24-32". (Note: lavender plants require two-to-three growing seasons to reach mature size)

GARDEN SEEDLINGS

Marketmore Cucumber – fruit averages 8-9” long, perfect for slicing. A favorite of home gardeners with high quality of flavor and texture that grocery store cukes simply can’t match!

Jupiter Bell Pepper – large, blocky 4-lobed, sweet-flavored fruits have thick green walls that ripen to red. Great for stuffing and freezing.

Green Machine Zucchini – produces tasty green-skinned fruit with light flecks; 6-7” in length. Easy to harvest because of the plant's naturally open growth habit. Needs room to grow so space plants 18 to 24 inches apart.

Athena Melon – consistently delivers early yields with dynamite flavor. The 6 x 8” fruit weigh 5–6 lbs, are coarsely netted, and have a scrumptious, bright orange flesh.

Crimson Sweet Watermelon – bright red flesh with high sugar content and few seeds; tough, medium-thick, light-green rind with small, dark-green stripes. Its shape is blocky at 12 x 10” and weighing up to 25 lbs.

Tomatoes

Red

Celebrity – great for container gardening! Medium-sized firm red tomato good for burgers and salads

Big Beef – old-fashioned beefsteak tomato taste, size (10-12 oz. each), and quality

Mountain Fresh – high yielder of 10 oz. fruits with firm, meaty flesh and a sweet, tangy flavor

Yellow

Valencia – golden meaty tomato with tangy flavor and very few seeds

Jubilee – large golden tomato with meaty, thick-walled interiors; low acid and mild flavor

Cherry

Great for container gardening! A nice compact plant that produces tons of 1 1/2" delicious **red cherry** tomatoes

Roma

The **San Marzano Roma** has balanced flavor; traditionally the tomato of choice for the best flavored tomato sauce

Heirloom

Arkansas Traveler – juicy, rose-pink slicer producing 5-7 oz fruits – very flavorful with a balance of sweetness/tartness

Cherokee Purple – beautiful dusky pink with a deep, rich-red interior; unmatched sweet taste on sandwiches and salads

German Lunchbox – an heirloom grape-sized tomato, sugar sweet and perfect for snacking or salads

Brandywine – large pink beefsteak-shaped fruit, popularly considered among the best tasting available

Striped German – large yellow and red delicious beefsteak with a complex tropical flavor and smooth texture

Red Oxheart – an excellent flavored unique, "ox heart" shaped red tomato variety

Wisconsin 55 – very sweet and flavorful; perfect for salads, slicing, sandwiches, and canning

Abe Lincoln – introduced in 1923 by the W. H. Buckbee seed company of Rockford, Ill., which named the tomato in honor of the state’s favorite son. Beautiful dark red fruits, sweet, solid and meaty. Ideal for ketchup, juice or slicing
